Child must be 16 years of age or younger at the time of application, live in the United States, and facing a health-related challenge.

Child must be covered by commercial/ private health insurance. This includes insurance through private employer, small business plans or plans offered through employment with a town, city, state or federal government.

Please note: The coverage does not have to be through UnitedHealthcare.

Family must not exceed maximum eligible adjusted gross income as documented on IRS Tax Form 1040

Most standard/FDA approved services are eligible. However exclusions do apply, some of those include Insurance Premiums, Home Modifications and Experimental/Unproven Services.

What can the grant cover?

Approved items related to: Deductible, Coinsurance and Copays as well as Non-Covered Services (ex: Therapies, Durable Medical Equipment, Hospital Stays, Medication, Mental Health Services and more)!

Lifecycle of a UHCCF Grant:



Family applies via UHCCF.org.



Completed application received by UHCCF (Applications presented monthly at regional board meeting).



Board decisions are communicated Board decisions are communicated via email and funds are available immediately after awarded immediately after awarded.



Once approved for a grant, the family will need to submit a request for payment online for approved medical services/items.





Payments may be issued to a provider, vendor or parent.

Due to the confidential nature of the information being shared, we are only able to accept payment requests directly from the approved family.

Important Reminder: Grants are available for medical costs incurred within 60 days from the time UHCCF determines the application to be complete. It will then be good for one year following the month in which it is approved. Don't wait, apply right away!

The UnitedHealthcare Children's Foundation (UHCCF) is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization that provides medical grants to help children gain access to health-related services not covered, or not fully covered, by their parents' commercial health insurance plan. Families can receive up to \$5,000 annually per child (\$10,000 lifetime maximum per child), and do not need to have insurance through UnitedHealthcare to be eligible. UHCCF was founded in 1999.

Since 2007, UHCCF has awarded more than 22,000 grants valued at over \$50M to children and their families across the United States. And we're just getting started. We're setting our sights on 2030, where we aim to award our 50,000th medical grant to families in need.
